CWSRF Applicants,

The State Water Board Division of Financial Assistance (Division) has received an overwhelming number of applications for Expanded Use SRF funds. Due to the limited amount of funds available from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) and the short timeframe for processing applications, Division staff will group and process the applications received as of Thursday April 30th at 4:00 PM. After April 30th, the FFAST system will remain open to Expanded Use SRF applications, but staff will not be actively processing the applications and will hold them for regular SRF processing once ARRA funds have been depleted.

In order to be considered for the limited ARRA funds available for new Expanded Use projects, a complete application must be submitted by 4:00 PM on April 30.
